
Verses at "Lord, I call" *Friday of the fourth week of the Great Fast*

In the seventh tone

10. Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Thy name.



9. The righteous will surround me; for Thou wilt deal bountifully with me. *Repeat: "Now is the acceptable time…"*

Then four stichera for the martyrs in the tone of the week.

8. Out of the depths I cry to Thee, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice. *(and the first sticheron to the martyrs)*

7. Let Thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications. *(and the second sticheron to the martyrs)*

6. If Thou, O Lord, shouldest mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with Thee.

(and the third sticheron to the martyrs)

5. For Thy name's sake I have waited for Thee, O Lord, my soul has waited for Thy word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

(and the fourth sticheron to the martyrs)

Then four stichera from the menaion. If only three stichera are given, repeat the first.

- 4. From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord.
- **3.** For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.
- **2.** Praise the Lord, all nations; praise Him, all peoples.
- **1.** For His mercy is abundant towards us; and the truth of the Lord endures for ever.

Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. *(and the doxastikon for the departed in the tone of the week)*

Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen. *(and the dogmatikon in the tone of the week)*
